The church premises consist of three parking lots: one large and two small. The larger lot is displaying signs of wear and has developed significant alligator cracking in multiple areas. The two smaller lots may just need a sealcoat. While we are open to suggestions from the winning contractor, we believe the following tasks should be included in the project:

- 1. Thorough cleaning of the parking lots.
- 2. Filling of alligator cracks.
- 3. Repairing any potholes and ensuring their proper filling.
- 4. Applying a sealant to protect the parking lots.
- 5. Re-striping the lots to ensure clear parking space delineation.
